CODE OF ETHICS FOR LIBRARY BOARD TRUSTEES

Board Chair:

Library Boards exist to develop, promote, and monitor library services as a public trust. Library trustees shall be committed to the following principles:

- 1. The primary goal of public library trustees is to ensure that the public has access to high quality library services.
- 2. Trustees shall ensure that each person has access to the most complete library service possible compatible with quality service for others.
- 3. Library trustees shall observe ethical standards.
 - A. Trustees shall avoid situations where personal advantage or financial benefits may be gained at the expense of other library users.
 - B. Trustees shall distinguish between their personal views and those of the institution by respecting the position of the Board, even though they may disagree.
 - C. In compliance with FOIP regulations, Trustees shall respect the confidential nature of library records within the framework allowed for the monitoring of material usage and the need for public accounting.
- 4. Trustees shall respect the established structure of the library.
 - A. Trustees will work collaboratively with the Board and shall ultimately accept its' will.
 - B. Trustees shall limit their trusteeship role to policy, governance, and advocacy.
- 5. Trustees are expected to take responsibility for their development as library board members through continuing education opportunities and participation in provincial library organizations.
- 6. Trustees will support the intellectual freedom of patrons in the selection of library material.
